FAQs: How are Burley All-Stars club requests processed? Maximum & minimum enrollment requirements vary for Burley All-Stars clubs depending on the program. We do our best to provide all students a balance of club opportunities. To help us process your club request, be sure to submit your club request online by Friday, Dec. 23rd!

How do students transition from dismissal?

On the day of their club meeting, students are dismissed after school by their classroom teacher and meet in the lunchrooms. Snack time begins at 3:15 and club teachers pick up their students at 3:30.

When do clubs start & end?

Program supervision begins at 3:15 and ends at 4:30. Please be sure that your child is picked up on time at 4:30. All clubs are dismissed from the Burley main entrance (east doors). Students registered in the YMCA after school program will be picked-up by YMCA staff at 4:30.

Can my child participate in both sports and clubs?

Yes! Burley's sports program is scheduled separately around our club program. More info will be shared at our upcoming sports informational meetings, which take place at the beginning of each sports season.

***Running Club (Grades 3-8)** – Students will practice and train in both endurance and short-distance running, and learn about ways that running can be a life-long benefit. This club meets also participates in a 5K at the end of the season.

Body Breaks & Games (Grades K-3) – This club will focus on physical activities that focus on good sportsmanship, teamwork, and fun! Each week students will be active and learn games that they can play with their friends from red light green light, freeze tag, and more join us to stretch your muscles.

Model United Nations (Grades 7-8) – How do you solve a global health crisis or negotiate with a nuclear-armed government? Tackle scenarios like these and learn about international relations, economics, global political systems, and diplomacy through research, debating, writing, and problem-solving in Burley's first ever Model UN!

Little Crafts (Grades K-2) – Use a variety of craft techniques, tools, and materials to create an exciting, new project every week! Materials provided.

Basketball (K-2): This semester our smallest players will get a chance to learn the Basketball basics. Coach Lewis will take you through the foundations of basketball to get ready for our Burley teams.

Jr Lego League (Grades 1-3) While exploring the real-world theme of animals, teams will use basic engineering concepts to build a model made of LEGO® elements. Students will have the opportunity to build as a group and individuals to see what they can come up with.

Guitar I: (4-8) In this club novice guitar players learn their way around the instrument. There is no previous experience required and students will learn about care, play, and fun you can have with a guitar.

Coding Club (3-8):

Interested in learning to code? Coding Club is for you! Using a selection of online and mobile resources, we will learn how to think like a programmer, how to apply that thinking to coding challenges, and begin write original code. Whether you've only skimmed the coding surface or have already taught yourself a programming language, the challenges we will take on in Coding Club will certainly add to your repertoire!

Sustainability Club (Grades K-8) The Sustainability Club at Burley is a club that is devoted to helping preserve the environment, learn about sustainability in our community and at Burley. The goal is to raise awareness about sustainability and the environment while actively participating and engaging in Burley's greenhouse, chicken initiative, worm composting, and spreading sustainability education around the building and community. This club meets on Tuesdays and Wednesdays so participants must be able to meet both days to apply.

Math Games and More (K-2): This club focuses on students using their numeracy and counting skills in a fun way via games. Each week students will have the opportunity to work in small groups and different games to build their math ideas.

Guitar II: (4-8) In this club guitar players that have ALREADY learned their way around the instrument during the Fall club sessions. Students will expand their learn about care, play, and fun you can have with a guitar.

Animation (3-8): Learn and explore the ins-and-outs of digital animation with Stykz! We will dive deep into the software and build our knowledge of the basic animation principles to create fluid animated stories. All levels of experience with the program are welcome, even if the program is new to you or if you've already created a masterpiece at home or in Tech Class.

Climbing Wall (5-8) Learn the basics of climbing on Burley's climbing wall. Students will learn about safety, stamina, and teamwork in this exciting afterschool program. Please make sure to wear climbing appropriate clothing and footwear.

Art Exploration (5-8): Learn a variety of art techniques and make some great items to take home with you. All materials are included with the club registration.

Making Ideas Real (digital fabrication + design thinking) Join the maker movement and learn to solve real problems by thinking like a designer. The Inventables team will help you learn and use design thinking to solve problems and understand the influence that design and innovation has on our lives. Equipped with the newest 3D carving machines and software, you can watch your ideas become reality!

Little Chefs (Grades K-2) – Make and eat yummy treats (no knives or heat involved)! Learn about food and the fun things food can make!

Board Games and More: Relax and unwind at the end of week with an exciting game with friends. In this afterschool club students will engage in thought provoking and fun board games. We will talk about sportsmanship, thinking skills, and rules of play. Each week we will have a new theme to investigate.
